Preventive measures and rules of conduct



S 24/25

Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Wash hands before breaks and after work.
Have eye wash bottle or eye rinse ready at work place.



Respiratory protection:

With correct and proper use, and under normal conditions, breathing protection is not required.

Hand protection:

Recommendation:

Protective gloves according to EN 374.

Glove material: Nitrile rubber.

Observe glove manufacturer's instructions concerning penetrability and breakthrough time.

Eye protection:

Tightly sealed safety glasses according to EN 166.

Reaction in case of danger

Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Accidental release measures:

Soak up with absorbent materials such as sand, siliceous earth, acid- or universal binder. Store in special closed containers and dispose of according to ordinance. Wash spill area with plenty of water.

First aid

Following inhalation:	Move victim to fresh air. In case of respiratory difficulties seek medical attention.
After skin contact:	Remove residues with soap and water. Change contaminated clothing. In case of skin irritation, consult a physician.
After eye contact:	Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Subsequently consult an ophthalmologist.
After swallowing:	Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Give water to drink in small sips. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do NOT induce vomiting. Risk of foam aspiration when vomiting. Immediately get medical attention.
